



**Optical Arrangements:**

- 1) 90° mirror diagonal - This gives an upright image that is reversed left-right. It is best optically and required for high magnification viewing.
- 2) 60° mirror diagonal - same note as above, but the 60° angle is more comfortable for terrestrial observing.
- 3) 45° erecting prism - For normal viewing. Limited to terrestrial viewing up to 60x.
- 4) 35mm SLR attachment with optional 1¼" Camera Adapter.
